Free Tutoring

Who is eligible?

Students attending Coffee Middle, George Washington Carver Freshman Campus and Coffee High School and are eligible for Free and/or Reduced lunch are eligible for Free Tutoring.



Who are the tutors?

Certified teachers are employed as tutors. Many of them are current employees of the Coffee County School System. Some are retired teachers.

Will transportation be provided?

Yes. Students will be transported to various drop-off points throughout the district.

When will tutoring be offered?

Students will receive approximately 20 hours of services as follows:

Coffee Middle School on Monday and Wednesday from 4:00 until 5:30.

GWCF and CHS on either Monday/Wednesday OR Tuesday/Thursday from 3:30 until 5:30.

What kind of instruction will be offered?

Students will be assigned to a tutor with no more than ten students per class. Instruction in reading/language arts or math will be offered using computer programs that are researched based and proven to be effective in increasing student achievement. Parents will receive a progress report every two weeks.
